The emergency department incorporates advanced communications technology - medics can now transmit EKG and other patient information from an accident site or ambulance to the hospital - allowing for advance cardiac prep and treatment for patients. The ER features a Fast Track service, which is a dedicated unit designed to treat minor injuries and illnesses. The first floor features cardiac/pulmonary rehabilitation, a heart station, outpatient lab draw station, registration and pre-admission testing. On the second floor is the new Medical-Surgical/Telemetry Unit with a 24-bed Intensive Care Unit. The new Telemetry/Progressive Care Unit is on the fourth floor. All patient rooms in the tower are completely private. The South Tower is accessible via the three-level parking garage which opened in July 2008.
